

What is permanent cosmetics?

It is the art and science of implanting color into the dermis, or second layer of skin. This process is used for cosmetic and corrective purposes and creates a lasting effect to accentuate and enhance the definition of eyebrows, eyes and lips.

I'm afraid of pain...does it hurt?

Topical anesthetics have been developed especially for permanent cosmetics. Most people are pleasantly surprised at how gentle the procedure is. Most patients report a mild vibration or tickling sensation.

How long will my makeup last?

With age, sun exposure, metabolism, and natural skin exfoliation it will fade somewhat after 3-5 years and can be "freshened" with a maintenance touch-up. However, the darker the color, the longer it will stay unchanged in your skin. This process varies from individual to individual according to their skin type and lifestyle.

How long is the procedure time and how long does it take to recover?

Initially, a medical history and consultation is arranged to determine shape, size and color. A scratch test is required. The consult can be done the same day as your procedure. The actual procedure time is 1 to 2 hours, depending on the areas receiving pigment. Aftercare instructions are given so you know exactly what and when to expect it. Recovery time is minimal and does not require time off from work. A slight swelling and redness and sometimes slight bruising will be present for 2-3 days. After 4-6 weeks, the procedure heals completely and a touch-up may be needed for perfection.

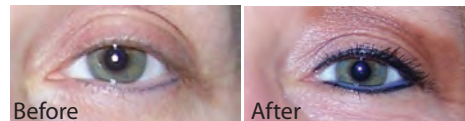
Eyelash Enhancement: Pigment is applied directly to the lash line to add definition. This procedure gives sparse lashes the appearance of thicker, fuller lashes.



Designer Eyeliner/Eyeliner/Smudge Eyeliner: The eyeliner can be as thin or thick as you like above the eyelash enhancement. It can be applied very naturally, softly, sophisticated or dramatic in appearance...the choice is yours.



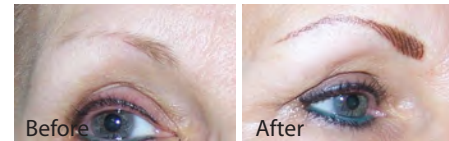
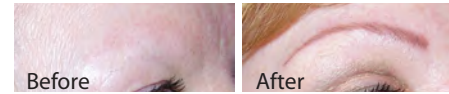
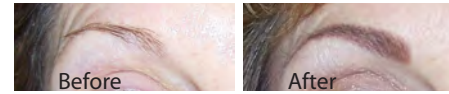
Mucosal Liner: Pigment is applied directly to the wet tissue above the bottom eyelash to enhance your eye color.



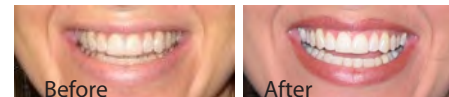
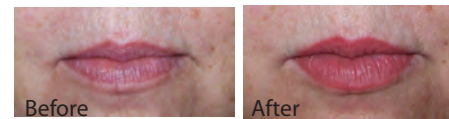

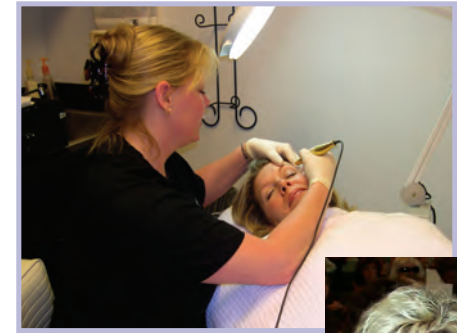
Hairstroke Eyebrows/Fill: The eyebrows are the "frame" of the face. The client's face shape and hair color are taken into consideration to customize accentuating brows. Eyebrows can be subtly pigmented to correct unevenness, softly arched to give a lift. Where there is no hair, hair strokes to create that realistic dimensional effect or a soft, powdered look can be achieved.



Full Lip Color/ Lip Liner: Lip color is great for defining shape, correcting uneven lip contours, and making lips appear fuller. Lip colors can be soft and natural or rich and vibrant. You must inform us if you have a history of fever blisters so medication can be prescribed 2 days prior to your procedure. We use numbing agents.
